Where are OMG there are so many options. = We going? OMG Let me tell you about my faves.







SEQUOIA & KINGS CANYON NATIONAL PARKS

BED


Camp bed, air mattress or luxury hammock, just make sure it's comfortable so you can get your zzz's. Bring your own awesome bedding and let your personality shine.


HERE'S MY IDEAL GLAMPING DIARY:








1 _{PH}	light lunch of salad and smoothie. I love smoothies. Did I mention I love smoothies?
